Mr. Keith Luhmann serves as the Associate Chief of Staff for Strategic Communications at the US Army Combat Capabilities Command Armaments Center (DEVCOM AC). In this role, Mr. Luhmann advises the DEVCOM AC Leadership Team on official communication strategies, leads the DEVCOM AC International Cooperation program, and manages both intramural and extramural innovation efforts leading to exploitation of emerging technologies. Prior to this assignment, Mr. Luhmann served as the Senior Scientific Technical Manager (SSTM) for Munitions Engineering and Technology Center (METC) Technical Planning and Execution, acting as Deputy Director and supporting a ~1000 person organization in the life cycle management of munitions systems technologies. Mr. Luhmann has also served as the Deputy Director of the Energetic and Warheads Directorate (EWD), and Chief of both the Propulsion Research and Development Branch and the Propulsion Pilot Processes Branch, responsible for enabling science & technology (S&T) to support the next generation gun propellants and propulsion systems and managing the DEVCOM AC Propulsion Pilot Plant. Other assignments throughout his career have included S&T Advisor to U.S. Army Pacific (USARPAC), Strategic Business Development for DEVCOM AC, Staff Specialist for Kinetic Weapons in the Office of the Undersecretary of Defense for Research & Engineering (USD(R&E)), Project Officer for the Project Manager for Combat Ammunition Systems (PM CAS), and Propulsion Engineer.

Mr. Luhmann grew up in Aroostook County in northern Maine, graduating from the University of Maine with a B.S. in Chemical Engineering in 2001. He is a graduate of the DoD Executive Leadership Development Program (ELDP) and holds an M.E. in Engineering Management from Stevens Institute of Technology with certificates of special study in Project Management and Systems Engineering.
